FIXED PENALTY GUIDELINES FOR STANDARD OFFENCES - Officials					
SENDING OFF OFFENCES - OFFICIALS					
SO1	Delaying the restart of play by the opposing team e.g. holding onto the ball, kicking the ball away, obstructing a player. (1 match)				
SO2	Deliberately leaving the technical area to show dissent towards or remonstrate with a match official, act in a provocative or inflammatory way. (2 matches)				
SO3	Entering the opposing technical area in an aggressive or confrontational manner (2 matches)				
SO4	Deliberately throw or kick an object onto the field of play (1 match)				
SO5	Enter the field of play to confront a match official; interfere with play, an opposing player or match official (2 matches)				
SO6	Physical or aggressive behaviour (including spitting or biting) towards an opposing player, substitute, team official, match official or another person (2 matches) *Disciplinary Committees should report concerns to SYFAprotection@scottish-football.com when appropriate				
S07	Receiving a second caution in the same match (1 match)

Cautionable offences - officials

C1	Clearly/persistently not respecting the confines of their teams technical area
C2	Delaying the restart of play by their team
C3	Deliberately entering the technical area of opposing team
C4	Dissent by word or action (includes gestures which show a clear lack of respect - sarcastic clapping)
C5	Excessively/persistently gesturing for a red/yellow card
C6	Gesturing or acting in a provocative or inflammatory manner
C7	Persistently unacceptable behaviour (included repeated warnings)
C8	Lack of respect for the game

N.B: No more than four trialists are allowed to participate in any match. Each trialist is allowed to participate in a maximum of four matches for any club (provided they are eligible to do so) .

Each team to provide two copies of team lines prior to match i.e. <u>one</u> copy for the opponent, and <u>one</u> for the Referee. Completed team lines for both teams, each signed by a club official and the referee, must be sent, by the referee to league or match secretary within 3 days
